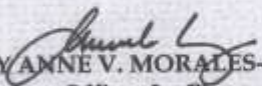

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

The undersigned incorporators, all of legal age and majority of whom are residents of the Philippines, have this day voluntary agreed to form a non-stock and non-profit association under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

THAT WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: The name of the said association shall be:

KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc.

SECOND: That the purpose or purposes for which such association is incorporated are:

1. To promote the welfare of the poor;
2. To extend financial assistance to its members in the form of death benefits, medical subsidy, pension and loan redemption assistance;
3. To ensure continued access to benefits/resources by actively involving the members in the direct management of the association that will include implementation of policies and procedures geared towards sustainability and improved services.

THIRD: That the place where the principal office the corporation is to be established or located is at # 5 Don Francisco St. Don Enrique Heights, Brgy. Holy Spirit Commonwealth Ave. Quezon City, Philippines. (as amended by the Board of Trustees at meetings held on March 25, 2010 amendments underscored)

FOURTH: That the term for which the association is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of issuance of the certificate of incorporation.

NINTH: That ROSALINA VERGARA has been elected by the members as Treasurer of the association to act as such until her successor is duly elected and qualified in accordance with the by-laws, and that such Treasurer she has been authorized to receive for and in the name and for the benefit of the association all contributions or donations paid or given by the members.

TENTH: That the association manifest its willingness to change its corporate name in the event another person, firm or entity has acquired a prior right to use the said firm name or one deceptively or confusingly similar to it.

ELEVENTH: That the association shall comply with the requirements for non-stock corporations in the course of its operations.

TWELVE: In case of dissolution, assets of the corporation shall be distributed to the following manner.

1. All its creditors shall be paid;
2. Assets held subject to return on dissolution shall be delivered back to their givers
3. Assets of the corporation shall be transferred to another accredited non-government organization or organization of similar purpose or purposes (as amended by the Board of Trustees at a special meeting held on Oct. 7, 2011).

AMENDED

BY-LAWS

OF

KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc.

(Name of Corporation)

ARTICLE I

MEETINGS

Section 1. Annual Meetings - The annual meetings of the members shall be held at the principal office of the association or any other feasible venue as may be decided by the Board of Trustees on any date in May 31 of each year. The President shall render her annual report to the members regarding the activities of the association. The election of trustees shall also be held during this annual meeting.

Section 2. Special Meetings - Special meetings of the members shall be called as the need thereof arises, by the Board of Trustees or the President or upon petition of 1/3 of the general membership.

Section 3. Notices - Notices of the time and place of annual and special meetings of the members shall be given either personally or by special delivery mail, at least two (2) weeks before the date set for such meeting. The notice of every special meeting shall state briefly the purpose or purposes of the meeting.

Section 4. Quorum - A quorum for any meeting of the members shall consist of a majority of the members and a majority of such quorum may decide any question at the meeting, except those matters where the Corporation Code requires the affirmative vote of a greater proportion.

Section 5. Order of Business - The order of business at the annual meeting of the members shall be as follows:

- a. Proof of services of the required notice of the meeting.
- b. Proof of the presence of a quorum.
- c. Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous annual meeting.
- d. Unfinished business.
- e. Report of the President.
- f. Election of the Trustees for the ensuing year.
- g. Other matters.

(Non-Stock Corporation)

Section 6. Voting Proxy - Members shall be entitled to one vote, and they may vote whether in person or by proxy which shall be in writing and filed with the Secretary of the association before the scheduled meeting.

ARTICLE II

TRUSTEES

Section 1. Board of Trustees - The Board of Trustees of the KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. shall consist of nine (9) members elected by the active members. One (1) trustee shall be an independent individual not connected nor involved in transactions dealing in KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. nor KASAGANA-KA Development Center, Inc. (as amended by the Board of Trustees at meetings held on March 27, 2015 and June 26, 2015. amendment underscored)

Section 2. Qualifications - The trustees to be elected must be of legal age, recognized active beneficiary member of the KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. or any of its affiliates, has consistently performed very satisfactorily for at least the last three (3) years in her membership and has ongoing businesses funded by loan from KASAGANA-KA Development Center, Inc. or any of its affiliates and is willing to perform the functions of a trustee without any remuneration. One trustee must be a personnel or staff of the KASAGANA-KA Development Center, Inc.

Section 3. Disqualification of Trustees or Officers - No member convicted by final judgment of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of the Corporation Code of the Philippines committed within five (5) years prior to the date of her election or appointment, shall qualify as a Trustee or Officer. In addition, a member whose membership has been terminated due to various reasons, and/or has resigned from membership with the KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. or any of its affiliates, shall also be disqualified from being a Trustee or Officer.

Section 4. Term of Office of Trustees Of the nine (9) trustees elected by the active members, the first seven (7) trustees elected with the highest number of votes will serve for a period of three (3) years and the last two (2) elected trustees will serve for two (2) years. The Independent Board may be re-elected for another two (2) years. Elections thereafter will only be for the positions of trustees vacated. (as amended by the Board of Trustees at meeting held on March 27, 2015 and June 26, 2015. amendments underscored)

(Non-Stock Corporation)

ARTICLE III

OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers - The officers of the association shall be a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. They shall be elected by the Board of Trustees from among themselves. The Board may combine compatible offices in a single person.

Section 2. Term of Office of Officers - The officers shall be elected by each new Board of Trustee at the first meeting after its election. Every officer shall be subject to removal only for cause, and unless so removed, shall hold office until his successor or successors are duly elected and qualified. (as amended by the Board of Trustees at a board meeting held on March 27, 2015 and June 26, 2015. amendments underscored)

ARTICLE IV

FUNCTIONS AND POWERS OF OFFICERS

Section 1. President - The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the association. She shall preside in all meetings of the members of the association.

She shall execute all resolutions of the Board of Trustees. She shall be charged with directing and overseeing the activities of the association. She shall submit to the Board as soon as possible after the close of each fiscal year, and to the members of each annual meeting, a complete report of the activities and operations of the association for the fiscal year under her term.

Section 2. Secretary - The Secretary shall give all notices required by these by-laws and keep the minutes of all meetings of the members and of the Board of Trustees in a book kept for the purpose. She shall keep the seal of the association and affix such seal to any paper or instrument requiring the same. She shall have custody of the members' register and the correspondence files of the association. She shall also perform all such other duties and work as the Board of Trustees may from time to time assign to her.

Section 3. Treasurer - The Treasurer shall have charge of the funds, receipts and disbursements of the association. She shall keep all moneys and other valuables of the association in such banks as the Board of Trustees may designate. She shall keep and have charge of the books of accounts. She shall also perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned to her from time to time by the Board of Trustees. She shall post a bond in such amounts as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees.

(Non-Stock Corporation)

ARTICLE V

MEMBERS

Section 1. Qualification for Membership – Applicants must be at least eighteen (18) years old but not more than (60) years old as of the enrollment date. He/she must be an active member of KASAGANA-KA Development Center, Inc. and other organized groups accredited.

Only those applicants who can meet all of the requirements stated in the prescribed application form shall be eligible for membership. Membership may include the staff and personnel of KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. and KASAGANA-KA Development Center, Inc. and its affiliate institutions, provided the fees and dues as herein specified are paid and application for membership in the Association is filed in the prescribed form.

Section 2. Rights of Members - A member shall have the following rights:

- a. To exercise the rights to vote on all matter relating to the affairs of the association;
- b. To be eligible to any elective or appointive office of the association;
- c. To participate in all deliberations/meetings of the association;
- d. To avail of all the facilities of the association;
- e. To examine all the records or books of the association during business hours.

Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities of the Members – A member shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To obey and comply with the by-laws, rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the association from time to time;
- b. To attend all meetings that may be called by the Board of Trustees;
- c. To pay membership dues and other assessments of the association.
- d. To participate in the governance and to protect the fund of the association.
- e. Continuously give suggestions and comments on how to better run the association.

Section 4. KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. shall issue membership certificates to members specifying the benefits to which such members are entitled. Such certificates, together with Articles of Incorporation of KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. and its by-laws and all existing laws as may be pertinent shall constitute the agreement, as of date of its issuance, between the KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. and the member.

(Non-Stock Corporation)

The Certificate of Membership shall continue during the life of the member unless otherwise terminated by death, total and permanent disability, resignation or expulsion.

ARTICLE VI

SUSPENSION, EXPULSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Suspension, expulsion and termination of membership, shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the association.

Any member of the association may file charges against a member by filing a written complaint with the Secretary of the association. The Board of Trustees shall call a special meeting to consider the charges. The affirmative vote of majority of all the trustees shall be necessary to suspend a member; Provided that where the penalty is expulsion, the affirmative vote of majority of all the members of the association or the affirmative vote of all the members of the Board of Trustees, shall be necessary.

ARTICLE VII

FUND

Section 1. Funds - The funds of the association shall be derived from members' contributions and special and special assessments of members, gifts or donations.

- a. Members shall be charged FIFTEEN PESOS (Php 15.00) contribution per week for the payment of death or total and permanent disability of a member or any member's legal spouse, or any of the member's biological and/or legally adopted children, ONE day old but not more than 21 years old and single; or biological children over 21 years old, single but disabled and incapacitated to work, or biological parent of a single (unmarried) member above 60 years old in accordance with the attached Table of KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association, Inc. *Life Insurance Benefits*.
- b. KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association shall deduct not more than 20% of the weekly contribution from its members as administrative expenses. The balance shall be used for paying mutual benefits as in accordance with the attached Table of KASAGANA-KA Mutual Benefit Association Life Insurance Benefits.
- c. The contributions may be adjusted by the Board of Trustees as may be necessary to maintain the funds of the Association at a level adequate to meet its benefit obligations or commitments under the plan.
- d. Every outstanding membership certificate must have, after three full years of being continuously in force, an equity value equivalent to at least fifty per centum of the total membership dues collected thereon. After three (3) full years of continuous membership in the Association, a member shall be entitled to an equity value equivalent to at least fifty per centum (50%) of the total membership dues

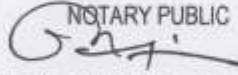
