

Board Resolution No. 17 Series of 2018

CREATION OF A HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE

Upon motion by Ms. Marissa Loyola and duly seconded by Ms. Anita Manundo, the KMBA Board of Trustees, in its regular meeting held on April 25, 2018, where a quorum was present, approved the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the KSO Coordinating Committee recommended the creation of a Human Resources (HR) Committee in each of the KSO entities, which will serve as the Retirement Board as well;

WHEREAS, the proposed Committee will study and recommend policies on recruitment, employee benefits and welfare, human resource development, succession and retirement, among others;

WHEREAS, the KSO Coordinating Committee further recommends that the HR Committee of KDCI composed of Ms. Maria Alexandra Pura, Atty. Henry Yusingco, Jr., and Mr. Jaime Varela, will serve as Committee Advisers;

WHEREAS, to avoid any conflict of interest, there was a suggestion to disqualify from membership in the proposed HR Committee those Board members whose spouse, child, parent or sibling is an employee of KMBA;

NOW, THEREFORE, the foregoing premises considered, the Board RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to form the Human Resources Committee, which shall be tasked to recommend policies on, among others, recruitment, employee benefits and welfare, human resource development, succession and retirement;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to disqualify from membership in the HR Committee Board members whose spouse, child, parent or sibling is an employee of KMBA;
