

## Board Resolution No. 34 Series of 2020

## CALAMITY ASSISTANCE TO AFFECTED MEMBERS DUE TO TYPHOON ULYSSES

Upon motion, duly seconded, the Board of Trustees, on November 17, 2020, in an online referendum, adopted the following resolution:

WHEREAS, following the devastation brought by tropical storm "Ulysses" in the operating areas of Kasagana-Ka, about 2,000 members as of reporting date, were affected, and a projected number of 125 families to have experienced dire property loss or totally damaged residential houses caused by floodwater and strong winds;

**WHEREAS**, KMBA, as its other services, caters access to post-emergency calamity assistance to members with damaged residential house following a natural or man-made catastrophe including typhoon, flooding, earthquake and the same in the amount of Three Thousand (Php 3,000.00) Pesos;

**WHEREAS**, in a meeting of the KSO Coordinating Committee in quorum, it was resolved to establish a common fund and extend assistance to victims in the form of food packs amounting to Two Hundred Fifty (Php250.00) Pesos per member/family;

**WHEREAS,** KMBA, after reviewing its 2020 budget and current finances, determined a total amount of Five Hundred Thousand (Php 500,000.00) Pesos available as a contribution to the fund;

**WHEREAS,** half of the amount, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (Php 250,000.00) Pesos, shall be allocated to food packs for the half of the affected members (1000 members × Php 250.00);

**WHEREAS**, the remaining Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (Php 250,000.00) shall be distributed as financial assistance to the 125 families greatly affected by the typhoon;

WHEREAS, to effect the latter provision, KMBA management recommended a decrease in the amount of cash assistance from Three Thousand (Php 3,000.00) Pesos to Two Thousand (Php 2,000.00) Pesos to accommodate all 125 families;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the foregoing premises considered, the Board of Trustees **RESOLVED** to approve the decrease in the amount of cash assistance from Three Thousand (Php 3,000.00) Pesos to Two Thousand (Php 2,000.00) Pesos to accommodate all 125 families for a total amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (Php 250,000.00) Pesos;

**RESOLVED FURTHER** to approve KMBA's contribution to KSO Relief Operations (food packs to affected members) amounting to another Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (Php 250,000.00) Pesos.

Adopted this 17<sup>th</sup> of November, 2020 via online referendum, in the Philippines by the affirmative vote of the undersigned members representing a majority of the trustees of KMBA, Inc.
