

Board Resolution No. 11 Series of 2022

APPROVAL OF LONG-TERM AND SHORT-TERM INVESTMENTS

Upon motion, duly seconded, the Board of Trustees, in a Regular Board Meeting held on May 31 2022, where a quorum is present, adopted the following resolution:

WHEREAS, upon assessment of the Treasury Committee, there is an available fund amounting Php 10,000,000 pesos that can be used for additional investment;

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the organization to invest these available funds which are not immediately needed for the operation and to receive the highest rate of return thereon in order to generate additional income to the Association;

WHEREAS, the Board desires to have these funds invested as soon as practicable without the necessity of a delay;

NOW THEREFORE, the foregoing premises considered, the Board of Trustees **RESOLVED** to approve the investment to the following investment offers:

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the funds should be invested in the manner set forth in this resolution, and the Management shall determine the best possible investment to be made, taking into consideration the rate of return for the investment, the length of time the investment must be placed and all other important factors to protect and enhance the interest of the Association;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a report to the Board, at its next regular meeting after these investments are made, for the purpose of reporting the transactions that have taken place.
